“Arts In the Park”
Saturday, August 14th 2010
Pioneer Park - Puyallup

The first public fine arts festival, presented by VALLEY ARTS UNITED in downtown Puyallup: all arts for all people! All parts of the festival, including the concerts, are free.

The festival will take place within the Farmer’s Market in Pioneer Park, on Saturday August 14th. Art booths will be open from 10-4pm. The art booths and exhibits will be located around the bandstand/stage and towards Meridian. Featuring: Northwest Sinfonietta, sponsored by the Puyallup Kiwanis Club. NWS will present a quintet to perform two family concerts of classical music with an animal theme. Also, NWS will offer a hands-on, interactive “Instrument Petting Zoo”. Additionally, VAU is organizing interactive art exhibits for youth and adults, and artists in action. An average of 2,500 people attend the Farmer’s Market on Saturdays in August.

Opportunity for artists with work for sale:

1. Artists with their own pop-up tent or up to 10’x10’ canopy are invited to apply to participate. The fee is \$50. An electrical outlet can be provided for an additional \$20 fee, specify your interest with your application. Please submit examples of your work or your website information to Rosemary Eckerson, address below.
2. Artists who don’t have a canopy can apply to be part of the “Artist Commons”. Please supply an example of your work and a description (type, and footprint size) of your proposed display. The fee to be part of the “Artist Commons” is \$10, and your space within the common canopy (provided by VAU) will depend on the number of artists. No displays or tables will be provided, and no electricity.
