Puyallup's Outdoor Gallery combines a permanent gallery which is owned by the city and a rotating gallery which is on loan for two years.

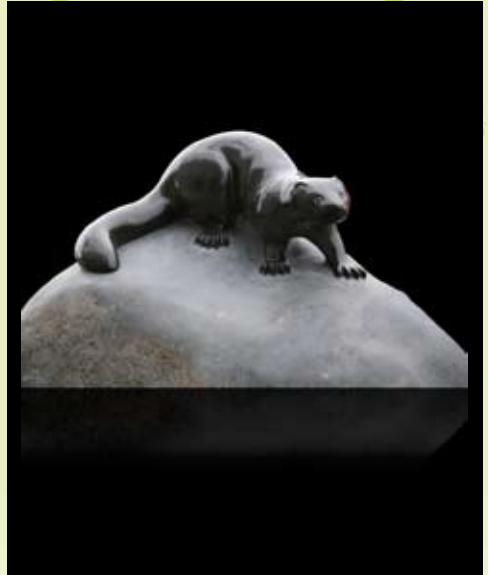

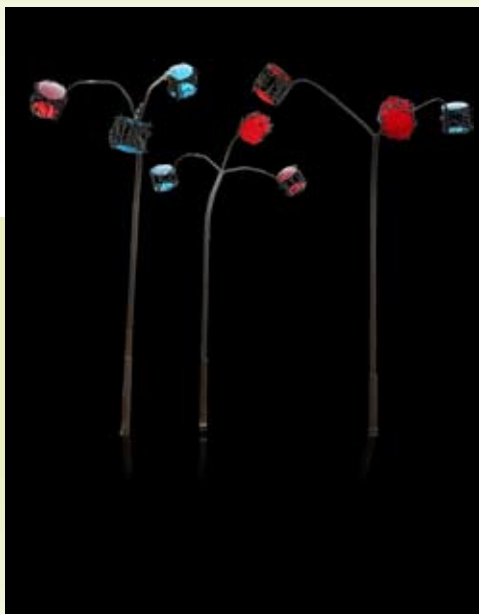

Arts Downtown offers many benefits to the participating artists:

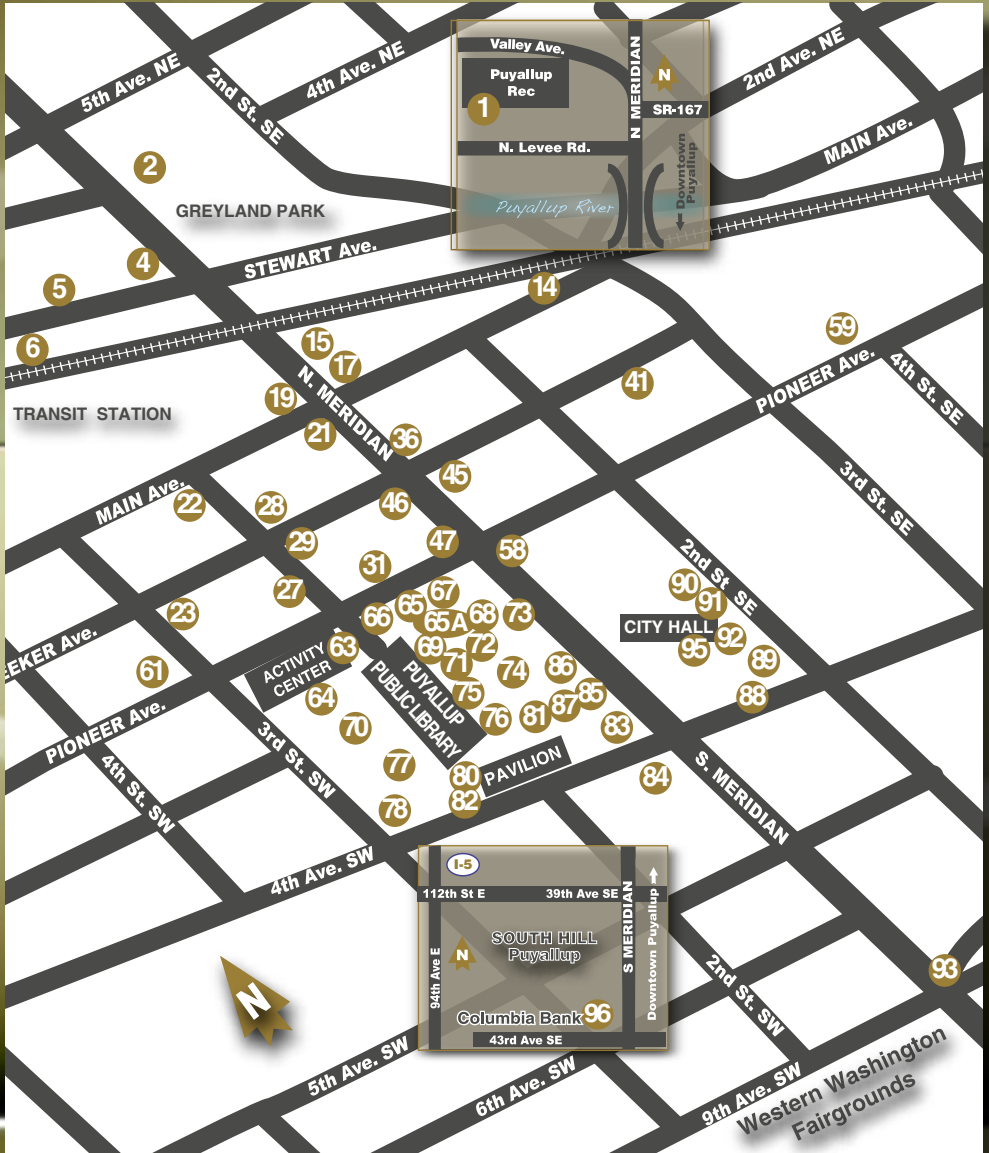

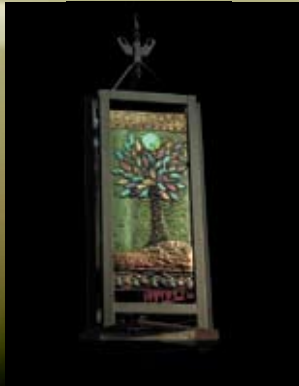

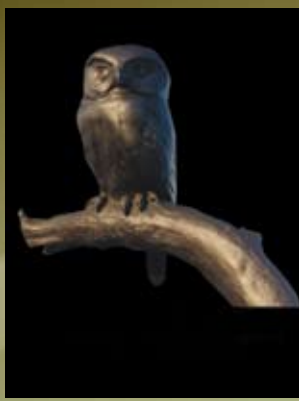

VALLEY ARTS UNITED'S OTHER GALLERIES

Valley Arts United is very proud of Arts Downtown, Puyallup's Outdoor Gallery. For 16 years Arts Downtown has worked relentlessly to build one of the most outstanding outdoor sculpture galleries in the state. It now boasts 39 permanent pieces in its collection. For a long time, Arts Downtown has annually purchased the community favorite to donate to the City of Puyallup. Last year it became a two-year rotation. The community favorite of the new, rotating pieces will be purchased for the City in the Spring of 2013.

In the past few years, VAU has added three other galleries:

Premier Gallery, City Gallery, and Gallery 3.

PREMIER GALLERY is located inside the Puyallup Activity Center. The gallery offers four shows per year of local artists, both established and emerging. It displays up to 45 pieces at a time. Hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

CITY GALLERY is located on the 5th floor of City Hall. This gallery also offers four shows per year of local artists. It displays up to 20 pieces at a time. Hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

GALLERY THREE is located on the ground floor of City Hall next to Subway. This gallery showcases the art of 15-20 local artists. There is a wide variety of affordable art that changes monthly. Hours are Tuesday through Sunday, 11:00 am. to 6:00 p.m.
